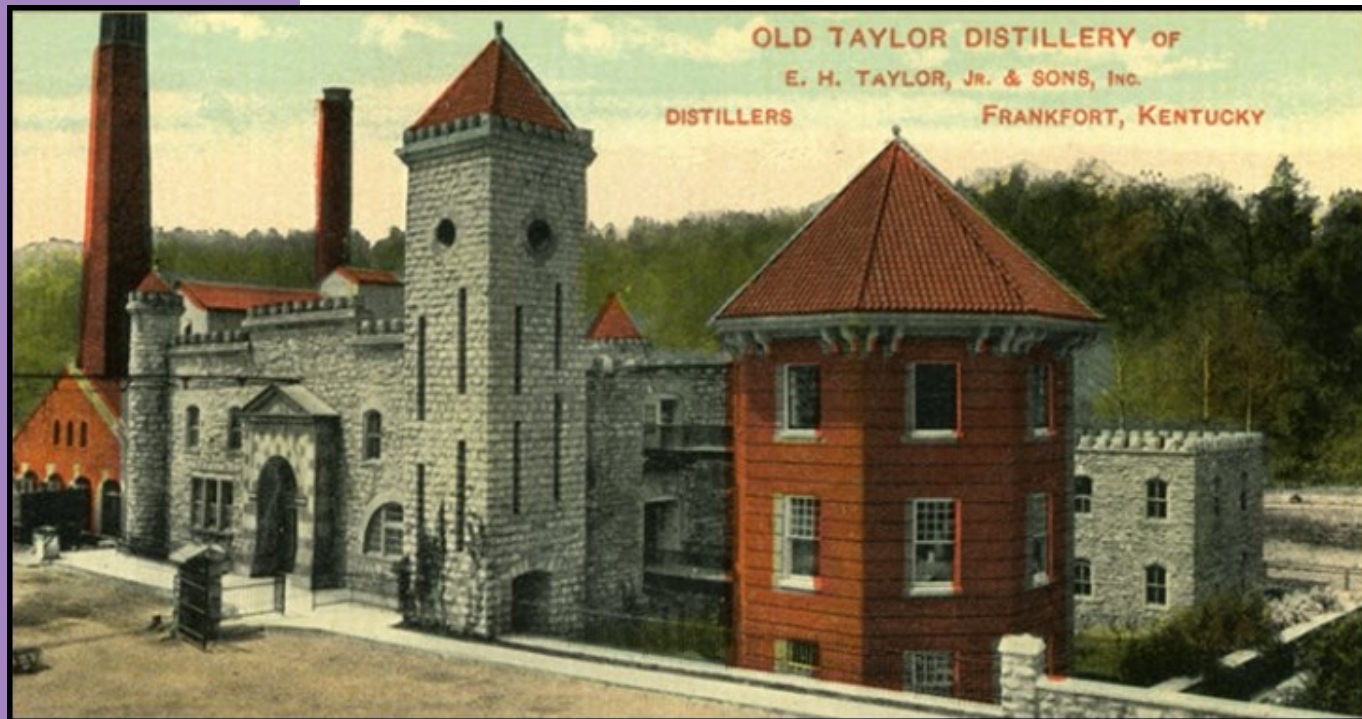

"Backing Up & Moving Forward:
Steps for Protecting Data & Preparing for a Recovery"
